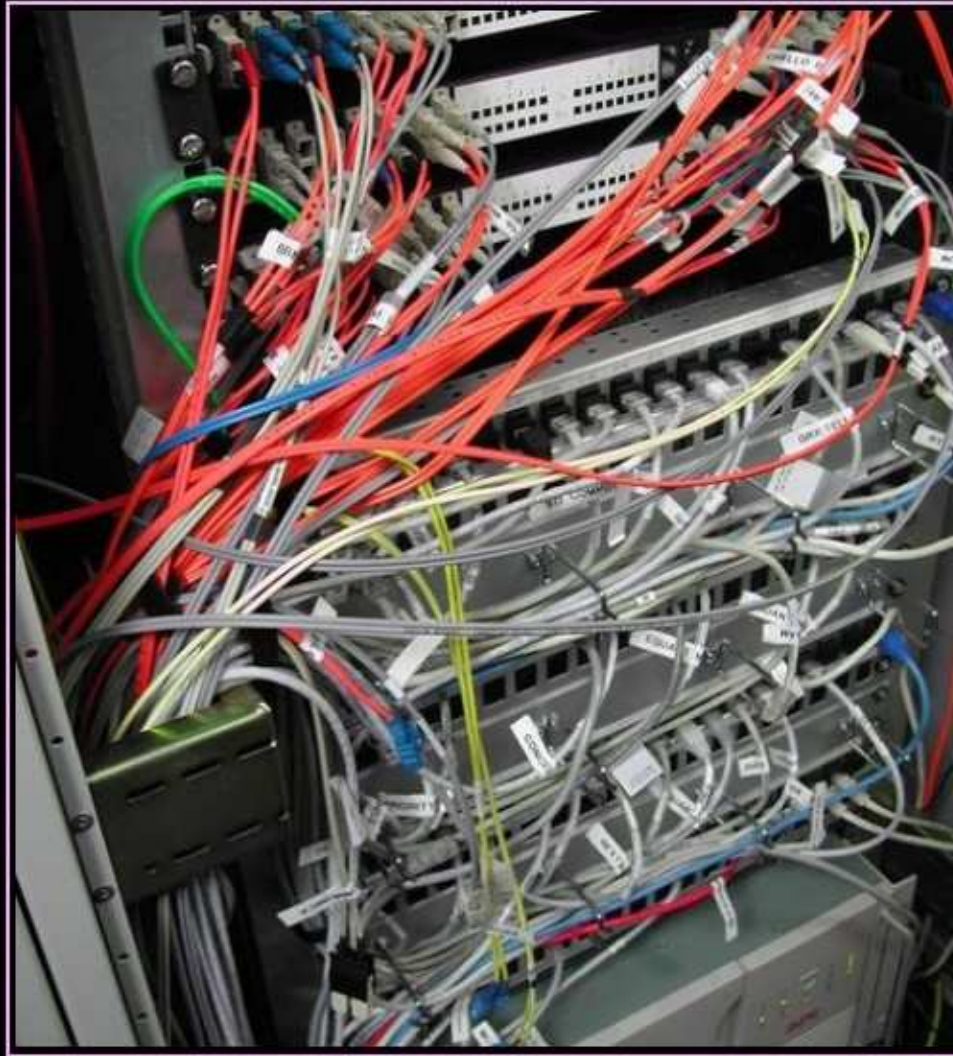
GET WET

It doesn't matter. Just get in the water.



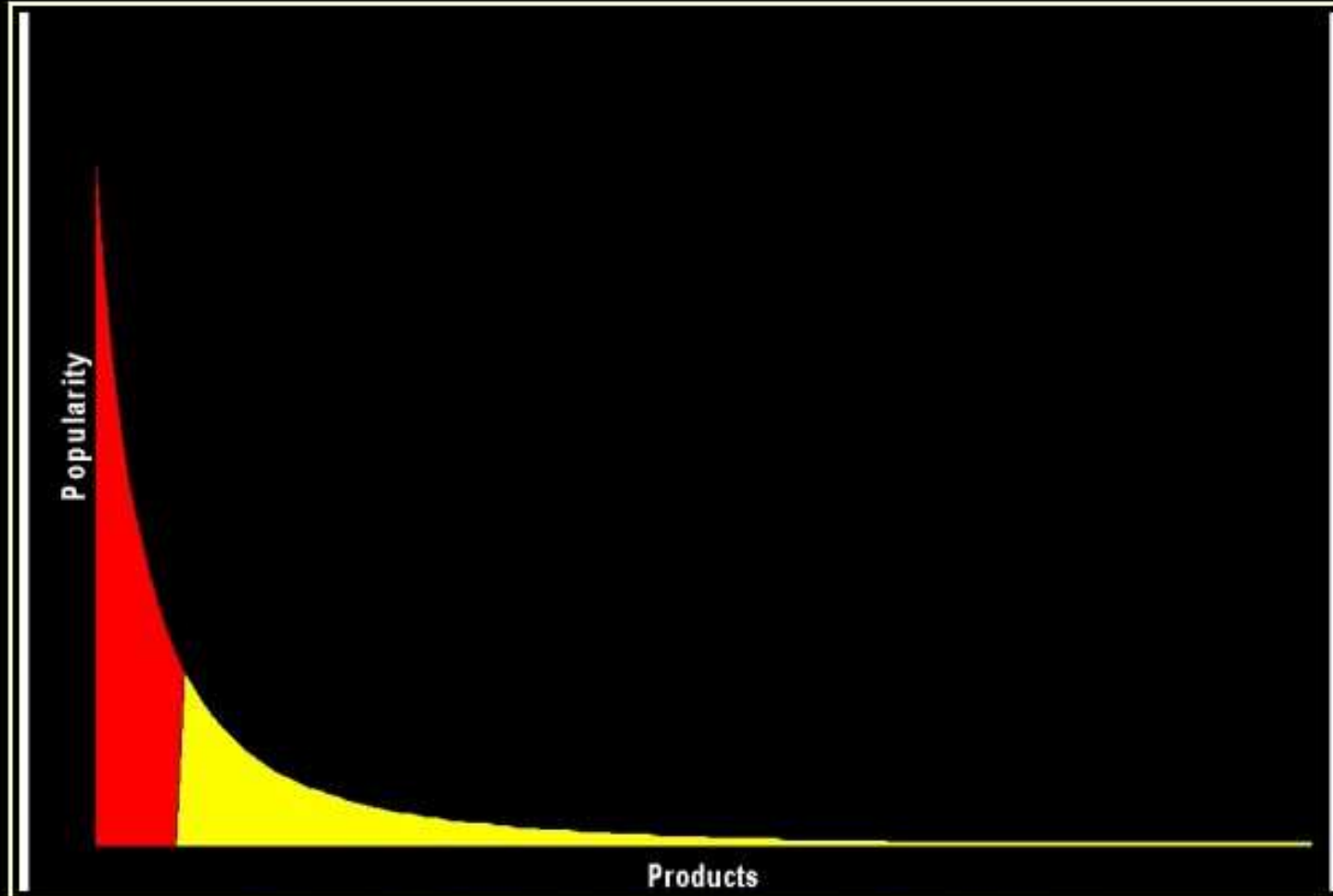
BLOG
